

## RULES AND LIABILITY WAIVER ROMAGNA 4 BIKE MTB&GRAVEL TRAIL

"Romagna4Bike – MTB & Gravel Trail" is a permanent ring route designed for mountain bike and gravel bike. It develops on 225km in the heart of the hilly territory of *Imola Faenza Tourism Company*.

The ring itinerary develops on mixed grounds with a total elevation gain of 5.573m.

## **SIGNING UP AND REGULATION**

The users hereby state that:

- A. They know the participation to this event is not a competition but a spontaneous excursion, without any leaderboards, designed for cycloturists and amateur cyclists.
- B. They know the organizational features of the event and itinerary, related height differences, the checkpoint and the activation mode, the information, rules and regulations of the off-road excursion with prize, curated by the promoter.
- C. They are aware parts of the itinerary could be difficult and challenging, therefore a good physical shape and technical riding skills are required.
- D. They will confront the most challenging parts of the route with maximum attention, without creating danger for themselves and others; , if considered too difficult, participants will choose decide to avoid said parts by choosing alternative paths od by getting off the bicycle.
- E. They do not use any substance (drugs, doping or medications) that may alter physical and psychological shape or may represent danger for themselves or the others.
- F. They are currently in good physical shape and the participation to this off-road biking excursion will be made in total safety for what concerns physical shape.
- G. They are aware of the Rules of the Road and they will respect them without any violation.
- H. In order to win the prize and diploma, they will register the passage through 5 checkpoints, located along the route to verify the real completing of the full 225km route. The checkpoint are located: Imola, Autodromo Enzo e Dino Ferrari, Aruba Tower; Castel del Rio, entrance of Palazzo degli Alidosi and War Museum; Riolo Terme Monte Mauro, on bulletin board of the Park, in the parking of Monte Mauro; Brisighella, Fontana Moneta lodge, on bulletin board of the lodge; Faenza, entrance of International Museum of Ceramics.
- I. Promoters do not take responsibilities in damages, either caused or suffered, nor for injuries that may occur while participating in Romagna4Bike Trail.

## **CODE OF BEHAVIOR**

Users commit to:

- A. Respecting and keeping clean all places crossed (roads, cycling paths, lawns, woods, paths and farms etc):
- B. Not littering whatsoever, by throwing garbage in specific bins;



- C. Wearing a protection helment and carrying gear for outdoor activities (such as bike, first aid kit, spare parts, etc);
- D. Not creating big groups and obstructing the regular road traffic;
- E. Using cycling paths and specific cycling areas when present;
- F. Using specific front white lighting and rear red lighting when natural light is insufficient and using high visibility clothing and gear;
- **G.** Keeping a respectful and correct behavior toward other participants and other regular users of the paths;
- *H.* Reporting to the promoter any disfunction or claim.

## **LIABILITY WAIVER**

Users hereby accept that:

- A. The Promoter is not a professional sport institution, but a turist promotion organisation with recreational purposes;
- B. The Promoter does not have any responsibility connected to the off-road cycling excursion Romagna4Bike; therefore, it is not responsible for any event happening before, during or after the course of the excursion, which may have caused physical or material damages to participants or other subjects (bike damages, getting lost, physical problems, accidents or thefts). The users participating renounce any legal action of any kind against the Promoter and its Legal Representatives.
- C. The Promoter is not required to verify requirements of bicycle gear and respecting the Rules of the Road (i.e., lighting devices on bicycle, technical gears and clothing, etc);
- D. Each participant travel and rides at his own risk, without any additional right compared to other users of the paths and roads;
